

The Chinese Fan Palm is a striking houseplant that will become a statement in any space. It features large, dramatic fronds that resemble a folded paper fan. When grown indoors it can reach a height of 6-8 feet.

This palm is native to the tropics of Southern Asia. It is a very hardy plant that can tolerate drought better than most other palms, so it is a great choice for a hands-off plant parent.

## **PALM** **'CHINESE FAN'**



## Light

Give this palm plenty of light.

Bright indirect/High

## Watering

Keep this palm evenly moist.

Never allow it to stand in water as it will rot the roots.

As with most palms, they like it humid as well so group it with other plants, get a humidifier, or pebble tray.

## Feeding

Apply a balanced liquid fertilizer such as *Espoma Organic Indoor Houseplant Food*, once a month from spring to fall.

## Planting & Care

Grow in a well draining potting soil like Black Gold® All Purpose soil amended with sand.

Please note: This palm has sharp barbs on the stems of its fronds. Use caution when moving or repotting.

## Size

This palm may get up to 8 feet tall and 4 feet wide.

## Flower

They can produce sprays of whitish-yellow flowers, but most likely not in the house.

## Temperature
