LEMON BUTTON FERN



Light

This fern can tolerate indirect, low, medium and bright indirect light. It's one of the most adaptable plant varieties available.

Bright indirect/Medium/Low

Watering

Keep this fern evenly moist, but not wet (fronds can rot in soggy potting soil). Allow the top of the potting soil to slightly dry out between waterings. Place on a tray of wet pebbles to raise the humidity.

Feeding

Apply a balanced houseplant fertilizer monthly from Spring to Early fall. We recommend, Espoma® Organic Indoor Liquid Organic Plant Food or Bonide Fish Fertilizer.

Planting & Care

Grow with Black Gold® All Purpose soil.
Repot in the spring as needed.

Ferns do not produce flowers.
