The leaflets are thin and small, which is the reason they need such high humidity. If a window is available in your bathroom or kitchen, they would love the elevated humidity. ## FERN MAIDENHAIR



## Light

A medium to bright indirect light is best, such as an east window or set back from a west window.

Bright indirect-Medium

## Watering

Keep the potting soil moist, not wet. The key to growing this delicate fern is to never allow it to dry out and to raise the humidity.



## Feeding

Feed every month during the growing season with a balanced houseplant fertilizer, such as Espoma Organic Indoor Houseplant Food.

## Planting & Care

Grow with Black Gold® All Purpose Potting mix amended with a bit of horticultural charcoal.

Repot every 2 years in the spring. If the plant starts to look worn, cut off all the stems at the base in spring; it will soon regenerate healthy growth.
