
Native to Southeast Asia, the Ginseng Ficus has a very striking appearance because it grows thick roots that stay exposed above the surface of the ground. If grown as a bonsai, the effect is of a small tree standing on its legs.

### Light

Bright indirect to high light is best. If placed outside during summer filtered light is best.

## **Watering**

Allow the top 1-2" of the potting soil to dry out between waterings.

## **Feeding**

Feed every month during the growing season with a balanced fertilizer, such as Jacks All Purpose Fertilizer, diluted to 1/2 strength.

## **Planting & Care**

Grow with Black Gold® All Purpose soil amended with horticultural charcoal and/or perlite. Repot when the root system has filled the pot, usually every other year in the summer.

#### **Size**

16-40 inches depending on how much is trimmed. This plan is easy to keep small. It makes an easy beginner bonsai tree.

#### **Flower**

This plant will not likely flower in the house.

## **Humidity**

While it will grow in low humidity it would prefer moderate to high.

#### **Care**

Average
