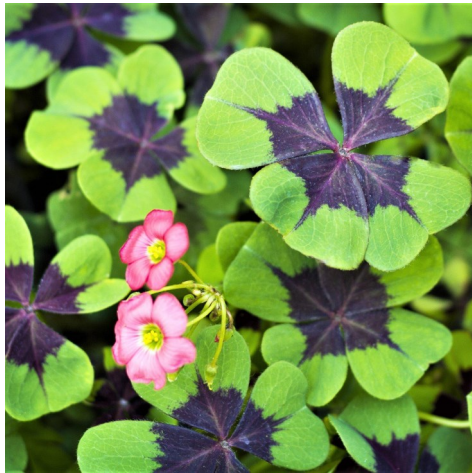


This is one of the easiest flowering houseplants to grow, often producing white or soft pink flowers continuously, except for a brief break in winter. The dainty flowers are held above triangular, clover like leaves. It is happy to grow in filtered sun indoors year-round, or you can move it outside to a shady patio or balcony in the summer.

Light

Bright indirect-medium

Watering

Allow the top of the potting soil to dry out between waterings. Light frequent waterings are needed to keep large plants constantly moist, bottom watering may help with this.

Leach pots occasionally to dissolve accumulated salts.



Feeding

Apply a balanced liquid fertilizer like Jack's® Classic All Purpose 20-20-20 monthly during growing season from Spring to Fall. Do not feed in Winter.

Planting & Care

Use an all purpose indoor potting mix, we recommend Black Gold® All Purpose Potting Mix.

Move plants to larger pots should they become crowded, or when salt deposits accumulate in containers.
