

Rhoeo oyster is a beautiful, low maintenance plant that features brightly colored leaves arranged in a rosette shape. It is native to Southern Mexico and Central America and enjoys bright and warm conditions. It grows upright rather than trailing, which is unique for plants in this family.

Light

Color will be more vibrant when exposed to very bright light.

Bright indirect/Medium

Watering

Allow the soil to dry out between waterings. When you water, water thoroughly until water comes out of the drainage hole, then remove any excess water.

Feeding

Feed every 2 weeks during the growing season with a balanced houseplant fertilizer, such as Espoma Organic Indoor Houseplant Food. Do NOT fertilize in the winter.

Planting & Care

Use an all purpose potting mix, we recommend Black Gold® All Purpose Potting Mix. Repot every 2-3 years as needed.
